

**RESOLUTION 2025-09**

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FLAGLER BEACH, FLORIDA TO CLOSE OUT THE BEACH MANAGEMENT RESERVE AND MOVE FUNDS TO THE DUNE PROTECTION RESERVE AND REDESIGNATE THE DUNE PROTECTION RESERVE AS THE DUNE WALKOVER RESERVE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City previously created a Beach Management Reserve, appropriating funds to undertake a beach study; and,

WHEREAS, said beach study was conducted and completed by Daytona State College in 2013 ; and,

WHEREAS, City staff seeks to reduce the number of funds and reserves (especially those that are dormant) to provide for more efficient financial reporting;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FLAGLER BEACH, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of Flagler Beach City Commission authorizes the Finance Director to transfer the current funds in the Beach Management Reserve to the Dune Protection Reserve.

SECTION 2. The City Commission approves the redesignation of the Dune Protection Reserve to the Dune Walkover Reserve, clarifying the intent and the use of the reserve funds for dune walkover repair and replacement.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage as provided by law.
