

RESOLUTION NO. 11526

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE
2026 AMERICAN RIVER CANYON SCHOOL DISTRICT BOUNDARY
AD HOC COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the Folsom Cordova Unified School District (FCUSD) provides excellent educational programs and facilities for transitional-kindergarten through 12 grade students (TK-12) in the cities of Folsom and Rancho Cordova; and,

WHEREAS, while the jurisdictional boundary of FCUSD does not formally extend into the American River Canyon area of the City, through agreement with the San Juan Unified School District (SJUSD), Folsom students living in the American River Canyon neighborhood have been permitted to attend FCUSD schools instead of schools operated and managed by SJUSD; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council desires a comprehensive review of the jurisdictional boundaries of FCUSD and SJUSD to determine whether adjustments should be made to formally incorporate the American River Canyon neighborhood into the FCUSD boundary; and,

WHEREAS, Section 2.04(G) of the City Charter authorizes the Mayor to establish ad hoc committees, subject to approval of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Folsom that the Mayor is hereby authorized to establish the 2026 American River Canyon School District Boundary Ad Hoc Committee in the following manner:

1. Members of the Ad Hoc Committee shall be comprised of:
 - A. Councilmembers: [to be determined]
 - B. One appointee by each Councilmember [to be determined]
 - C. Parents of students living in the American River Canyon neighborhood of the City [to be determined]
2. The Committee is established for a period not to exceed one (1) year from the date of this Resolution.
3. Each member of the Committee shall have one vote, and the decisions of the Committee shall be made by majority vote.
4. Committee members at the first meeting shall choose a Chair and a Vice Chair.
5. The City Manager may assign staff resources to provide administrative support and subject matter expert services to the Committee.

6. The Committee is tasked to conduct a comprehensive review of the jurisdictional boundaries of FCUSD and SJUSD and make recommendations to the City Council whether adjustments should be made to formally incorporate the American River Canyon neighborhood into the FCUSD boundary.
7. The Committee will submit a report and recommendations to the City Council no later than 12 months from the first Committee meeting.
8. The meetings of the Committee shall be held at least monthly and shall be established at a regular time. The date and times of such meetings shall be noticed as required by the Brown Act, and the public shall be encouraged to participate.
