SUBJECT:	Appointment of At-Large Historic Preservation Member to the Folsom Historic District Commission
FROM:	City Clerk's Department

RECOMMENDATION / CITY COUNCIL ACTION

Staff requests that the Mayor, with approval from the City Council, appoint an at-large historic preservation member to the Folsom Historic District Commission for a two-year term ending in December 2023.

BACKGROUND / ISSUE

<u>Folsom Municipal Code</u> Chapter 17.52 establishes the Folsom Historic District Commission and defines the Committee's purpose of the Historic District Commission, in part, as to preserve and enhance the historic, small-town atmosphere of the Historic District; to encourage an active business climate which promotes the development of a diverse range of businesses compatible with the Historic District; to retain the residential areas within the Historic District; to ensure that new residential and commercial development is consistent with the historical character of the Historic District; and to increase the awareness, understanding, and appreciation of the history of the city.

The Commission is comprised of seven members consisting of one representative who is actively involved with historic preservation, one representative who is a resident of the Historic District, one representative who owns a business within the Sutter Street Subarea, two Planning Commissioners, one representative from a Historic District business outside the Sutter Street Subarea, and one architect, landscape architect, or other design professional with expertise in historic preservation.

Two members of the Planning Commission are designated by ordinance to serve on the Historic District Commission. Historically the Planning Commission has voted to recommend members of the Planning Commission to serve on the Historic District Commission.

At-Large Members

The current vacant position is for an applicant representing the Historical Society / Historic Preservation. The vacancy was created due to the expiration of a two-year terms that ended in December 2021.

A Notice of Vacancy was published in the City's newsletter, posted on the city's website, and on the bulletin boards located at City Hall and the Library. Correspondence was sent to current Historic District Commission members whose term expired in December 2021 inviting them to submit an application for reappointment.

POLICY / RULE

<u>Folsom Municipal Code</u> Section 2.35.030 states that at-large appointments to the Historic District Commission shall expire as follows:

December of even numbered years:

- Planning Commission Members (2 appointees)
- Representative from a Historic District Business outside the Sutter Street subarea
- Architect, Landscape architect, or other design profession

December of odd-numbered years:

- Historic Preservation
- Resident of the Historic District
- Business Owner within the Sutter Street subarea

<u>Folsom Municipal Code</u> Section 17.52.020 states that the mayor shall appoint each of the members, subject to the approval of the city council.

ANALYSIS

There is currently one vacancy for a representative of the Folsom Historic District Committee consisting of an applicant representing the Historical Society / Historic Preservation. The two-year term will end in December 2023.

The City has received four applications for the at-large seat:

I have worked closely with architects and engineers to understand and incorporate historical integrity in both design and construction. I am a current member of the Folsom Historical Society and the Murer House Foundation.

Secondly, I bring a strong working knowledge of CEQA and the land use entitlement process. I continue to develop my knowledge of local Folsom policy and ordinances related to the Historic District. I have worked primarily over the last 25 years on the applicant side CEQA/NEPA land use entitlements as a project manager, and more recently as the Environmental Manager, for a large local construction company. I also have experience working on the lead agency side of the entitlement process for SMUD as a CEQA/NEPA Project Manager.

Lastly, I have experience working with communities, non-profits, business organizations and people. In this capacity, I continue to work constructively and fairly with different groups of stakeholders with varying degrees of Interest and needs. 1. Why do you want to serve on this commission or committee:

I want to serve on the HDC to be a part of making a difference in the Historic Area and improving its success as a residential neighborhood as well as a strong commercial entity. History can speak for itself, but needs a voice. I advocate to be that voice. While I have seen many changes in the historic district over the years, I believe that the residents and their voices have not been heard. I have lived in this district for over 40 years and have been an active participant. Some examples are setting up City Council Forums, participating in Historic Folsom Residents Assoc. which allowed me to set up the one and only meeting at Granite Center to invite residents to learn more about "Granny Flats." In 2001, I volunteered to represent the Historic District in finding locations for affordable housing. I am good at volunteering and have been available for my city time and again. I was on the Planning Commission for over 9 years only missing 2 meetings. I understand what commitment is and will take this position seriously.

2. What do you think is(are) the top issue(s) facing this commission or committee:

I think the top issues facing the historic district are parking, traffic and the increasing high density of housing. I bring up high density due to the increase enhancement of "granny flats." I understand the desire to own a rental on your property, as I have one. I am concerned about the increase of people buying a house, property and building a "granny flat." The standards have changed since I built mine, the residence no longer requires a homeowner to live in one of the properties, thus making high density more likely and allowing non-homeownership only complicates this problem. The historic district is becoming a rental community with residents not really connected or responsible to be a good neighbor. This can lead to many problems.

There are only so many parking spaces and this problem needs attention.. Traffic will get worse population increases. I have been aware of this for many years, living on the corner of Sibley St. and Natoma St. Getting 4 way stop signs was a blessing that I am glad to say I was a part of. Consistency is important. The rule is to stop at every intersection. I have been candid about the districts' problems and I hope you trust my judgment.
