

RESOLUTION NO. 11471

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CALIFORNIA WOOD RECYCLING, INC., DBA AGROMIN, FOR AN ESTIMATED \$45 MILLION FOR UP TO 15 YEARS FROM THE SOLID WASTE OPERATING FUND (FUND 540) FOR LONG-TERM ORGANIC WASTE DIVERSION SERVICES

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383) requires jurisdictions to reduce landfill disposal of organic material generated in the state, thereby fighting climate change by reducing Short Lived Climate Pollutants; and

WHEREAS, to comply with SB 1383, the City of Folsom must provide residential collection of source separated organic waste; and

WHEREAS, the city’s ability to divert residential organic waste from the landfill requires a contractor qualified to process organic waste into new products; and

WHEREAS, the city participated in a joint procurement process with the County of Sacramento and the City of Sacramento to secure long-term organic processing capacity; and

WHEREAS, the entity selected through the joint procurement, Agromin, has the expertise and the means to provide organic materials diversion services; and

WHEREAS, the agreement will secure organic waste processing capacity for up to fifteen years beginning in Fiscal Year 2027-28; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the Solid Waste Fund (Fund 540); and

WHEREAS, the agreement will be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Folsom authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with California Wood Recycling, Inc., DBA Agromin, for an Estimated \$45 Million for up to 15 years from the Solid Waste Operating Fund (Fund 540) for Long-Term Organic Waste Diversion Services.
