

**RESOLUTION NO. 11469**

**A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO.11389 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR DESIGN CONSULTING AND COMMUNITY-BUILD CONSTRUCTION ASSISTANCE SERVICES WITH LEATHERS & ASSOCIATES FOR THE KID’S PLAY PARK RENOVATION PROJECT (PROJECT PK2501) FOR \$111,569 IN THE PARKS & RECREATION EQUIPMENT/CAPITAL FUND (FUND 609)**

**WHEREAS**, Folsom Kids Play Park, with its castle-themed wood play structure, was built in 1996 and has reached the effective end of its useful life and requires complete replacement; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 31, 2025, staff issued a Request for Proposal for playground design services for Folsom Kids Play Park with the intent of the project being built by a contractor; and

**WHEREAS**, on April 20, 2025, Leathers & Associates submitted a proposal for design services with limited construction assistance for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$81,640; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 27, 2025, City Council directed the project be changed to a community build; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 27, 2025, the City Manager was authorized to execute a Design and Consulting Services Agreement with Leathers & Associates for design services for the Kid’s Play Park – Play Structure Replacement Project (Project PK2501), for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$81,640.

**WHEREAS**, upon notification of project scope changing to a community-build, Leathers & Associates increased their contract amount to \$111,569 to cover additional construction superintendents' time required to lead the volunteers and the associated travel expenses; and

**WHEREAS**, The Kid’s Play Park – Play Structure Replacement Project (Project PK2501) is included in the FY 2025-26 Capital Improvement Plan with a project budget of \$800,000 in the Parks and Recreation Equipment/Capital Fund (Fund 609); and

**WHEREAS**, sufficient funds are budgeted and available to cover the cost of the agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Design and Consulting Services Agreement shall be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Folsom rescinds Resolution No. 11389 and authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement for Design Consulting and Community-Build Construction Assistance Services with Leathers & Associates for the Kid’s Play Park – Play Structure Replacement Project (Project PK2501), for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$111,569.
