

RESOLUTION NO. 11466

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH INFERRERA CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT GROUP, INC. FOR \$409,268 FROM THE WATER OPERATING FUND (FUND 520) FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE WATER SYSTEM FLOW CONTROL FACILITIES REHABILITATION PROJECT (WA2302) AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City has identified this project as a priority to maintain the integrity and operation of the City's water distribution system; and

WHEREAS, the rehabilitation work identified to enhance the City's water distribution system includes rehabilitating existing water distribution pressure reducing valve stations, relocating below grade pressure reducing stations to above grade, and to continue to provide reliable water service to the City; and

WHEREAS, Inferrera Construction Management Group, Inc. by reason of their past experience, knowledge, and abilities for performing these types of services, are qualified to perform the required construction management and inspection services for the project; and

WHEREAS, the Water System Flow Control Facilities Rehabilitation Project (WA2302) is included in the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Capital Improvement Plan with a project budget of \$2,005,000; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the in the Water Operating Fund (Fund 520), however an appropriation in the amount of \$84,211 is needed for the project, increasing the overall project budget to \$2,089,211; and

WHEREAS, the agreement will be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Folsom authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with Inferrera Construction Management Group, Inc. for Construction Management and Inspection Services for the Water System Flow Control Facilities Rehabilitation Project (WA2302) for an amount of \$409,268; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Finance Director is authorized to appropriate \$84,211 in the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Water Operating Fund (Fund 520) for the Water System Flow Control Facilities Rehabilitation Project (WA2302).
