

**RESOLUTION NO. 11472**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT WITH IMPERIAL CONSTRUCTION & ENGINEERING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$233,000 USING GREEN MEANS GO GRANT FUNDS IN THE DRAINAGE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (FUND 448) FOR THE BIDWELL STREET STORM DRAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT, PROJECT NO. 2499**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Folsom desires to repair and rehabilitate the existing storm drainage infrastructure along Bidwell Street from Wool Street to Decatur Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the project was awarded a \$305,000 Green Means Go Capital grant award for construction with no required local match; and

**WHEREAS**, the project was originally advertised for construction on June 18, 2025, and the City received only one bid and, upon review, elected to reject the bid and readvertise the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the project was readvertised on August 13, 2025, and bids were received on September 3, 2025, with Imperial Construction & Engineering, Inc. being the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder with a bid of \$233,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the engineer's estimate of probable cost was \$250,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bidwell Street Storm Drain Replacement Project, Project No. 2499 is included in the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Capital Improvement Plan with an adopted budget of \$305,000 in the Drainage Capital Improvement Fund (Fund 448); and

**WHEREAS**, Green Means Go grant funding in the amount of \$300,000 is available for use on the construction phase of the project with a grant expenditure end date of December 31, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, grant funding activity for the project will be recorded in the Drainage Capital Improvement Fund (Fund 448); and

**WHEREAS**, the contract will be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Folsom authorizes the City Manager to execute a Construction Agreement with Imperial Construction and Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$233,000 Using Green Means Go Grant Funds in the Drainage Capital Improvement Fund (Fund 448) for the Bidwell Street Storm Drain Replacement Project, Project No. 2499, with the budgeted amount to include a 10% contingency in the amount of \$23,300 for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$256,300.
