

RESOLUTION NO. 11489

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A DESIGN AND ENGINEERING CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH BENNETT ENGINEERING SERVICES, INC. FOR THE CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT STORM DRAIN REALIGNMENT PROJECT PHASE 1 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$142,924 FROM THE SB1 ROAD MAINTENANCE AND REHABILITATION FUND (FUND 235), AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Folsom conducted a hydraulic analysis of the East Bidwell Street Corridor from Coloma Street to Orchard Street and identified numerous deficiencies and recommended improvements of the overall storm drainage system along the corridor; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to realign the existing substandard storm drain that crosses 511 East Bidwell Street into dedicated drainage easements for improved access and maintenance and bring it up to current City standards; and

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) on September 9, 2025 for design and consulting services to realign the existing storm drain across 511 East Bidwell Street and solicited proposals from the Environmental and Water Resources Department's short list of qualified engineering design consulting firms; and,

WHEREAS, Bennett Engineering Services, Inc. submitted a proposal in response to the RFP and was selected as the top-ranked consultant through a competitive evaluation process based on qualifications, experience, and technical approach; and

WHEREAS, an appropriation of \$142,924 in the SB1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Fund (Fund 235) will be required; and

WHEREAS, the contract will be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Folsom authorizes the City Manager to execute a Design and Engineering Consultant Services Agreement with Bennett Engineering Services, Inc. in the amount of \$142,924 from the SB1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Fund (Fund 235) for the Central Business District Storm Drain Realignment Project Phase 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Finance Director is authorized to appropriate \$142,924 in the SB1 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Fund (Fund 235) for the Central Business District Storm Drain Realignment Project Phase 1.
