

RESOLUTION NO. 11483

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE
AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT (CONTRACT NO. 173-21 22-067) WITH
EAGLE AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY INC. DBA EAGLE AERIAL SOLUTIONS FOR
\$226,500 FOR A FIVE-YEAR PERIOD FROM THE WATER OPERATING FUND
(FUND 520) TO MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF ASSEMBLY BILL 1668 AND
SENATE BILL 606 REGARDING LANDSCAPE IRRIGATION FOR RESIDENTIAL
SITES**

WHEREAS, in 2018 the legislature of the State of California passed Assembly Bill 1668 and Senate Bill 606 for water conservation and drought planning; and

WHEREAS, this legislation requires measuring the landscape areas and calculating water budgets at all residential sites; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental and Water Resources Department solicited scopes of work in May of 2022 for services to include water use analysis and calculating water budgets of all residential sites; and

WHEREAS, Eagle Aerial Photography Inc. dba Eagle Aerial Solutions was chosen based on its WaterView program and by reason of their past experience with numerous municipalities and water districts and the State of California, Department of Water Resources; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement (Contract No. 173-21 22-067) with Eagle Aerial Photography Inc. will be effective as of December 20, 2025, and cover Fiscal Years 2025-26 through 2029-30 at an annual cost of \$45,300 for a not-to-exceed total amount of \$226,500; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are budgeted and available in the FY 2025-26 Water Operating Fund (Fund 520) and are also planned to be included in the Water Operating Fund budgets for Fiscal Years 2026-27, 2027-28, 2028-29 and 2029-30 as part of the annual budget adoption process; and

WHEREAS, the agreement will be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Folsom authorizes the City Manager to Execute Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement with Eagle Aerial Photography Inc. dba Eagle Aerial Solutions to Meet the Requirements of Assembly Bill 1668 and Senate Bill 606 Regarding Landscape Irrigation for Residential Sites for \$226,500 over five years.
