

RESOLUTION NO. 11491

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CAPRA ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES FOR SHADED FUEL BREAK CREATION AND LADDER FUEL REMOVAL (PROJECT # 8131) AND USE OF FUND 010 (GENERAL FUND), FUND 204 (LOS CERROS), FUND 215 (PRAIRIE OAKS RANCH NO. 2), FUND 210 (BROADSTONE 1 & 2), FUND 266 (BROADSTONE NO. 3), AND FUND 207 (NATOMA STATION) FOR A NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$213,336.50

WHEREAS, the City of Folsom desires to enter into a professional services agreement for an initial period beginning November 1, 2025, through July 31, 2026, for shaded fuel break creation and ladder fuel removal; and

WHEREAS, proposals were solicited in accordance with Folsom Municipal Code Section 2.36.100 and advertised on May 20, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Capra Environmental Services was the most qualified contractor; and

WHEREAS, the total value of the agreement will be \$213,336.50; and

WHEREAS, up to 75% may be reimbursed through a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Grant; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are budgeted and available in the amount of \$213,336.50 in the Fiscal Year 2025-26 budget across several funds, including Landscape and Lighting Districts, Community Facilities Districts, and the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the agreement will be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Folsom authorizes the City Manager to execute an Agreement with Capra Environmental Services for Shaded Fuel Break Creation and Ladder Fuel Removal and use of Fund 010 (General Fund), Fund 204 (Los Cerros), Fund 215 (Prairie Oaks Ranch No. 2), Fund 210 (Broadstone 1 & 2), Fund 266 (Broadstone No. 3) and Fund 207 (Natoma Station) for a Not-to-Exceed Amount of \$213,336.50.
