A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE FOLSOM BOULEVARD PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROJECT FOR SB-1 LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (LPP) FUNDING ALLOCATION FROM THE STATE'S ROAD MAINTENANCE AND REHABILITATION ACCOUNT

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Transportation Authority (STA) funding share for the SB-1 LPP (Formulaic) program for this two-year period is \$6,334,000; and

WHEREAS, the STA Board of Directors adopted a distribution methodology among Sacramento County, the Cities, and Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT) where SacRT receives 22.5 percent of the available funding and the remainder is divided among the County and the Cities using the Measure A formula of 75 percent by population and 25 percent by road lane miles; and

WHEREAS, the City of Folsom has been allocated \$264,000 in unprogrammed Cycle 4 funds and \$308,000 in Cycle 5 funds, for a total of \$572,000 in LPP funding; and

WHEREAS, staff is proposing to program these funds to the Folsom Boulevard Pavement Resurfacing project, which will repair and resurface the pavement on Folsom Boulevard between Aerojet Road and Natoma Station Drive; and

WHEREAS, once the project is approved by the California Transportation Commission, staff will return to Council for approval of the source of the required match funding, to accept the grant award, and to request an increase to revenue estimates and appropriations for the amount awarded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Folsom Approves the Submittal of the Folsom Boulevard Pavement Resurfacing Project for SB-1 Local Partnership Program (LPP) Funding Allocation from the State's Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account.
