## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO FOR \$177,646.98 TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RESPONSE TEAM SERVICES FROM THE GENERAL FUND (FUND 010)

**WHEREAS,** effectively responding to, managing, and controlling hazardous materials incidents requires highly specialized training, equipment, supplies, and communication systems to ensure the safety and protection of both the public and emergency responders; and

**WHEREAS,** the County of Sacramento has contracted for the services of the City of Sacramento and Sacramento Metropolitan Fire Protection District Hazardous Materials Response Teams to respond to emergency incidents in the cities and unincorporated areas of Sacramento County; and

**WHEREAS,** the funding for these services has been budgeted in the FY 2025-26 General Fund (Fund 010) with future year contract amounts being included as part of the annual budget process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Folsom costs through the term of this contract are set at:
