WHEREAS, the CERT volunteer program plays a key role in the City of Folsom's goal to protect and advance community safety; and

WHEREAS, CERT volunteers work closely with the Folsom Fire Department and help provide assistance on incidents and trainings; and

WHEREAS, last year, 43 CERT members volunteered 3,900 total hours and assisted in 418 activations; and

WHEREAS, CERT staffed cooling centers in Folsom during the heatwaves in June, August, and September of 2022. They also assisted with the severe weather conditions in December of 2022; and

WHEREAS, CERT supported our neighboring communities by assisting Incident Management Teams on the Rices Fire, the Electra Fire, and the Mosquito Fire; and

WHEREAS, CERT provided firefighter rehabilitation for several fires in Folsom and supported the Folsom Fire Department during captain training exercises, EMS testing, and burn drills.
