RESOLUTION NO. 11386

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE SAFE STREETS FOR ALL GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Grant Program was established under the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act) to support local communities in their efforts to prevent roadway fatalities and serious injuries; and

WHEREAS, the SS4A program provides funding for the development or updating of Comprehensive Safety Action Plans, as well as for the implementation of infrastructure and operational safety improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Folsom Public Works Department has identified priority roadway safety projects through its Local Roadway Safety Plan (LRSP), Capital Improvement Program (CIP), and Active Transportation Plan (ATP); and

WHEREAS, City staff has evaluated and identified several candidate projects that align with the SS4A program goals; and

WHEREAS, a local funding match of at least twenty percent (20%) of the total project cost is required if grant funds are awarded, which would be met through eligible local funding sources to be identified upon award.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Folsom hereby authorizes the City Manager to submit an application for funding through the U.S. Department of Transportation Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Grant Program, to pursue federal funding opportunities to enhance roadway safety for all users in the City of Folsom.
