

RESOLUTION NO. 11388

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A DESIGN AND CONSULTING SERVICES CONTRACT WITH KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC. FROM A \$1,040,000 FEDERAL GRANT WITH A LOCAL COST SHARE OF \$134,743 FOR THE FOLSOM LAKE CROSSING SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PHASE 2 PROJECT AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS IN THE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT FUND (FUND 446)

WHEREAS, the City of Folsom Public Works Department has identified the need to improve safety along the Folsom Lake Crossing corridor through Phase 2 of the Folsom Lake Crossing Safety Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, Public Works staff prepared and publicly advertised a Request for Proposals (RFP) for design and consulting services to support corridor analysis, concept development, and preliminary design on March 12, 2025 and received proposals from two firms; and

WHEREAS, a review panel consisting of three Public Works engineering staff analyzed the proposals using methods consistent with Chapter 10 of the Caltrans Local Assistance Project Manual requirements for consultant selection; and

WHEREAS, staff selected Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. as the top-ranked consultant based on qualifications, experience, and technical approach; and

WHEREAS, the design and consulting contract will include data collection, crash analysis, evaluation of safety countermeasures, and the preparation of conceptual and preliminary designs to improve multimodal safety and operations along the corridor for a not to exceed amount of \$132,443; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project is provided by Congressionally Directed Spending funds of \$1.04 million and a local match of \$134,743 from the Transportation Improvement Fund (Fund 446); and

WHEREAS, an appropriation of funds in the amount of \$1,174,743 for the \$1,040,000 grant award and \$134,743 local matching funds is needed and sufficient funds are available in the Transportation Improvement Fund (Fund 446) for this appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the agreement will be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Folsom authorizes the City Manager to execute a design and consulting services contract with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for the Folsom Lake Crossing Safety Improvements Phase 2 Project for an amount not to exceed \$132,443.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate \$1,174,743 for the \$1,040,000 grant award and \$134,743 locating matching funds

creating the budget for this agreement. The appropriation will be in the Transportation Improvement Fund (Fund 446).
