

**RESOLUTION NO. 11415**

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT OF \$65,000 FROM THE URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH PEREGRINE TECHNOLOGIES FOR \$64,000 FOR A REAL-TIME DECISION AND OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT PLATFORM AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS IN THE GENERAL FUND (FUND 010)**

**WHEREAS**, the Sacramento Regional Office of Homeland Security Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) has negotiated an offer from Peregrine Technologies to offer it's real-time solution and analytics platform to UASI area agencies at a substantial discount; and

**WHEREAS**, the UASI has offered a grant to cover the base price of \$64,000 for the first year of service, with options to continue the service if funding is available; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department believes that data sharing and analytics provided by this program will enhance service to the community and the apprehension of criminal violators; and

**WHEREAS**, the contract with Peregrine Technologies will be in a format acceptable to the City Attorney.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Folsom hereby authorizes the City Manger to accept the UASI grant in the amount of \$65,000 and execute an agreement with Peregrine Technologies for their analytic software for an amount not to exceed \$64,000, and that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase revenue estimates and expenditure appropriations by \$64,000 in the General Fund (Fund 010).
