

## **RESOLUTION NO. 11443**

### **A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH FEHR & PEERS FOR A SUSTAINABLE TRANSIT CONNECTIONS TO HEALTH SERVICES PLANNING AND FEASIBILITY STUDY CONTRACT**

**WHEREAS**, in January 2024, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 11155 authorizing City staff, in partnership with the Sacramento Regional Transit District (SacRT), to apply for the Caltrans Fiscal Year 2024/25 Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant Program for a proposed transit planning and feasibility study focused on expanding access to major health services and key destinations in the Folsom Plan Area; and

**WHEREAS**, in July of 2024, Caltrans conditionally awarded \$218,472 in grant funding, with the City of Folsom serving as the lead applicant and SacRT as a partner agency; and

**WHEREAS**, in August 2024, the City Council approved Resolution No. 11249 authorizing the City Manager to execute related grant agreements, formally accept the full award, and appropriate funds in the amount of the grant for \$218,472 in the Light Rail Impact Fee Fund (Fund 451); and

**WHEREAS**, a Restricted Grant Agreement was finalized in October 2024, and a subsequent administrative budget amendment was approved in July 2025 to proceed with project implementation; and

**WHEREAS**, specialized consulting services are necessary to provide professional support in the areas of project management, data analysis, technical planning, stakeholder coordination, and community engagement; and

**WHEREAS**, in March 2025, the City issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to identify a qualified consulting firm for the preparation of the project study, and Fehr & Peers was selected based on its qualifications and understanding of the project scope; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Chapter 2.36 of the Folsom Municipal Code, professional services contracts valued at \$75,049 or more require approval by the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the contract will be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Folsom hereby authorizes the City Manager to Execute a Professional Services Agreement with Fehr & Peers, in an amount not to exceed \$150,315, to provide consultant services necessary for the project.
