SUBJECT:	Appointment of At-Large Members to the Folsom Historic District Commission
FROM:	City Clerk's Department

#### RECOMMENDATION

Staff is requesting that the Mayor, with the consent of the City Council, appoint two business seat representatives to the Historic District Commission for the terms ending as identified:

- A. Representative from a Historic District business outside the Sutter Street Subarea; *term ending December 2022*
- B. Representative who owns a business within the Sutter Street subarea; *term ending* December 2021

## **BACKGROUND / ISSUE**

The terms of all at-large appointments to City of Folsom commissions and committees (except three of the at-large appointments to the Historic District Commission) expire in December of even numbered years. Councilmember Rosario Rodriguez previously served as the representative who owns a business within the Sutter Street subarea; with her election to the Folsom City Council in November 2020, an appointment needs to be made to fill the remainder of that term.

## **POLICY**

<u>Folsom Municipal Code</u> Section 17.52.020 establishes the Historic District Commission as a seven member commission appointed by the Mayor with the consent of the City Council. Specific seat requirements are set forth as:

- A. One representative who is actively involved with historic preservation;
- B. One representative who is a resident of the historic district;
- C. One representative who owns a business within the Sutter Street subarea;
- D. Two planning commissioners;
- E. One representative from a historic district business outside the Sutter Street subarea;
- F. One architect, landscape architect, or other design professional with expertise in historic preservation.

<u>Folsom Municipal Code</u> Section 17.52.040 provides that members of the Historic District Commission are appointed to serve two years.

### ANALYSIS

The following two seats on the Historic District Commission are currently vacant:

- One representative who owns a business within the Sutter Street subarea
- One representative from a historic district business outside the Sutter Street subarea

The vacancy was advertised in the Folsom Telegraph, on the city's webpage and on social media. The city has received three applications, which are now presented for the City Council's consideration and appointment.

- A. Representative from a Historic District business outside the Sutter Street Subarea; *term ending December 2022* 
  - 1. Applicant: John Felts
- B. Representative who owns a business within the Sutter Street subarea; *term ending December 2021* 
  - 1. Mark Dascallos
  - 2. John Voelz


The applicants are eligible for these seats based upon their businesses and the business location.



1. Why do you want to serve on this commission or committee:

First, our business is here in the District. The major reason we have our business located in the Historic District is because of the the story it tells and the vibe that is created there. Reset's commitment to a quasi-Victorian artistic space would not have translated the same in any other area of the city.

Second, our family is connected to the District. My wife and I have lived nearly half of our married years in the Folsom area. We've owned three homes here. The Historic District has always played a huge part in our Folsom life. When we dated as teenagers, we would come to the District. I used to play music in the median on Sutter Street when I was in my 20s and 30s--often times right out in front of the building that I currently own a business in. Our children's memories are full of Historic District restaurants and outings. We always dreamed of living in the District and purchased a home here 5+ years ago. Protecting what I've known for the last 30+ years is important to me.

Third, I believe I have something to offer as an innovator. I have a penchant for problem solving and generating ideas. I don't want to just occupy space in the Historic District, I want to give back to her and have her be the best possible version of herself.

2. What do you think is(are) the top issue(s) facing this commission or committee:

The historic and cultural character of the City's Historic District are challenged aesthetically, functionally, and in regard to its personality and vibe. This is true of any Historic District that lives and seeks to thrive through change and progress. In order to thrive and not be caught off-guard by changes, a Historic District must have a futurist mindset--to get ahead of changes and lead through them.

We need to better tell the beautiful story of the District and attract more people to her.

Parking continues to be an issue for the District for business owners and homeowners alike--especially homeowners just removed from Sutter Street off of Figueroa.

COVID has obviously presented problems for all of us. The City and the District have been very lienient and flexible to help businesses succeed. Moving forward, the District needs to be proactive in revisiting conditional use permits, signage, and consistent design.

Educating or re-educating merchants on life in the district--the do's and don'ts and rules of the road. Some merchants may not know what's expected and some disregard those expectations.
