## A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR 9-1-1 EQUIPMENT MAINTENANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2024-25 maintenance term for the Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) Customer Premise Equipment (CPE) is scheduled to expire in April 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2025-26 maintenance term will begin in April 2025 and end in April 2026; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the Fiscal Year 2024-25 and Fiscal Year 2025-26 maintenance totals \$117,814.89; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has authorized funding for the City in the amount of \$117,814.89 for 9-1-1 equipment maintenance; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the General Fund (Fund 010) and will be fully reimbursed by the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services; and

**WHEREAS**, the agreement will be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Folsom hereby approves the acceptance of the funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services for 9-1-1 Equipment Maintenance in the amount of \$117,814.89, and that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase revenue estimates and expenditure appropriations by \$117,814.89 in the General Fund (Fund 010).
