SUBJECT:	Updating Appointment of City Council Representatives to Regional Boards/Commissions

RECOMMENDATION

Staff requests that the City Council update the appointment of City Council representatives to regional boards/commissions.

BACKGROUND / ISSUE

In addition to their primary duties on the City Council, the Mayor and Councilmembers represent the City of Folsom on various regional bodies. These assignments ensure that Folsom's interests are effectively advocated for in broader discussions regarding transportation, housing, economic development, and environmental sustainability. Through this participation, the Council plays a vital role in shaping policies that impact both the city and the greater Sacramento region.

Current assignment proposals are based on the individual interests and expertise of Councilmembers, allowing for informed and effective advocacy. Furthermore, the distribution of these roles seeks to equitably allocate responsibilities - including positions that offer stipends - to maintain a fair and balanced workload across the Council. This collaborative approach leverages the unique strengths of each member, strengthening Folsom's regional influence and ensuring professional, impactful governance.

2026 Updates

Regional assignments are periodically reviewed and adjusted to meet current needs. Minor modifications have already been made for the Retirement Board of Authority (under the Mayor's authority) and the Greater Sacramento Economic Council (under the City Manager's authority). An additional modification is proposed for the Sacramento Homeless Policy Council.

Please note that the Sacramento Homeless Policy Council may undergo a formal name change during the upcoming year. Should this occur, the City Council's appointments will automatically transition to the successor entity to ensure continuity of representation without requiring further formal action.

POLICY / RULE

Each regional board and commission operates under its own specific enabling legislation, bylaws, or joint powers agreements, which dictate the composition and appointment process for board members. The City Council exercises its authority to designate representatives to these external bodies to ensure Folsom's interests are represented in accordance with each entity's governing documents.
