RECOMMENDATION / CITY COUNCIL ACTION

Staff recommends that the City Council designate Councilmember Barbara Leary and Mayor Justin Raithel as the primary and alternate voting delegates, respectively, for the League of California Cities 2026 Annual Conference business meeting.

BACKGROUND / ISSUE

Every year, the League of California Cities convenes a member-driven General Assembly at the Cal Cities Annual Conference and Expo. The General Assembly is comprised of voting delegates appointed by each member city and presents an important opportunity where city officials can directly participate in the development of Cal Cities policy.

The appointed voting delegate plays an important role during the General Assembly by representing the city and voting on resolutions. To cast a vote during the General Assembly, each city must designate a voting delegate and up to two alternate voting delegates, one of whom may vote if the designated voting delegate is unable to serve in that capacity. Voting delegates may either be an elected or appointed official.

Councilmember Barbara Leary and Mayor Justin Raithel both indicate they will attend the Annual Conference and are willing to serve as the voting delegates.
