

RESOLUTION NO. 11457

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH WESTERN SYSTEMS, INC. FOR \$160,906.25 FROM THE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT FUND (FUND 446) TO PURCHASE CABINETS AT FOUR LOCATIONS FOR THE FLASHING YELLOW ARROW PROJECT

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2025, the City Council approved Resolution No. 11379 authorizing the Public Works Department to implement a Flashing Yellow Arrow (FYA) Trial Project to improve traffic flow, reduce emissions, and enhance driver experience; and

WHEREAS, to implement the trial project, upgrades to the existing traffic signal controller cabinets are required to ensure compatibility with modern equipment and allow efficient maintenance and troubleshooting; and

WHEREAS, the City has standardized its traffic signal cabinet specification to the Western Systems, Inc. P-Plus cabinet, which was developed in coordination with City staff and tested for compatibility with existing infrastructure, thereby improving safety and operational efficiency; and

WHEREAS, Western Systems, Inc. provided a quote dated June 3, 2025, for the necessary cabinets and components to serve the four project locations, with a total cost, including equipment, shipping, and tax, of \$160,906.25; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds in the amount of \$160,906.25 are budgeted and available in the Transportation Improvement Fund (Fund 446) for the purchase; and

WHEREAS, the agreement will be in a form acceptable to the City Attorney:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Folsom hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with Western Systems, Inc. in the amount of \$160,906.25 to purchase four P-Plus cabinets and related components for the Flashing Yellow Arrow Trial Project.
