## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-**

A RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS KIMBERLY JAMES, DABOUZE ANTOINE, HECTOR GUTIERREZ, LATRESA AKINS-WELLS, AND ALLAN MEARS TO APPROVE THE RENAMING OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO THE GROUNDS MAINTENANCE DIVISION.

WHEREAS, the City of Forest Park ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia; and

**WHEREAS,** the City's Public Works Department ("Departments") requests to rename the Parks and Recreation Division is primarily responsible for landscaping, maintenance, and repairs of City properties; and

WHEREAS, the Department requests to rename the Parks and Recreation Division to the Grounds Maintenance Division in order to minimize confusion with the Parks and Leisure Department which oversees recreational programming and parks events; and

**WHEREAS**, the approval of the new name for the division is necessary for the efficient operation of City affairs.

## THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF FOREST PARK, GEORGIA HEREBY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1.</u> Approval. The Department's request to rename the Parks and Recreation Division to the Grounds Maintenance Division as presented to the Mayor and City Council on October 7, 2024, is hereby approved.

**Section 2.** *Public Record.* This document shall be maintained as a public record by the City Clerk ("Clerk") and shall be accessible to the public during all normal business hours of the City.

<u>Section 3.</u> *Authorization of Execution.* The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

**Section 4.** *Attestation.* The Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 5.</u> *Effective Date.* This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Forest Park as provided in the City Charter.
