A RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS KIMBERLY JAMES, DABOUZE ANTOINE, HECTOR GUTIERREZ, LATRESA AKINS-WELLS, AND ALLAN MEARS TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) CHEVROLET SILVERADO FLEET VEHICLES FROM THE CITY'S PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the City of Forest Park ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the City's Public Works Department ("Department") has recently been conducting the aging vehicle replacement initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Department has determined the purchase of a 1500 Chevrolet Silverado from Hardy Chevrolet Buick GMC, Inc. for the City's Fleet Division in an amount not to exceed thirty-six thousand, seventy dollars and 00/100 cents (\$36,070.00); and

WHEREAS, the Department has determined the purchase of a 2500 Chevrolet Silverado from Hardy Chevrolet Buick GMC, Inc. for the City's Building Maintenance Division in an amount not to exceed fifty-nine thousand, five hundred and forty-four dollars and 00/100 cents (\$59,544.00); and

WHEREAS, the total cost of both vehicles from Hardy Chevrolet Buick GMC, Inc. shall not exceed a total cost of ninety-five thousand, six hundred and fourteen dollars and 00/100 cents (\$95,614.00) from capital vehicles line item 301-51-1540-54-2503; and

WHEREAS, the approval of the purchase of these two (2) vehicles is necessary to protect the welfare, health, and safety of City citizens.

THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF FOREST PARK, GEORGIA HEREBY RESOLVES:

Section 1. Approval. The Department's request to purchase two (2) Chevrolet Silverados from Hardy Chevrolet Buick GMC, Inc. in an amount not to exceed a total cost of ninety-five thousand, six hundred and fourteen dollars and 00/100 cents (\$95,614.00) for the City's Fleet Division and the City's Building and Maintenance Division as presented to the Mayor and City Council on October 7, 2024, is hereby approved.

Section 2. Public Record. This document shall be maintained as a public record by the City Clerk ("Clerk") and shall be accessible to the public during all normal business hours of the City.

Section 3. Authorization of Execution. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

Section 4. Attestation. The Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Forest Park as provided in the City Charter.
