## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-**

A RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS KIMBERLY JAMES, DABOUZE ANTOINE, HECTOR GUTIERREZ, LATRESA AKINS-WELLS, AND ALLAN MEARS TO APPROVE THE RENAMING OF THE CITY'S TRADE SPECIALIST DIVISION TO THE CITY'S BUILDING MAINTENANCE DIVISION.

WHEREAS, the City of Forest Park ("City") is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the City's Public Works Department ("Departments") requests to rename the Trade Specialist Division which is primarily responsible for maintaining systems and infrastructure across City buildings and structures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department requests to rename the Trade Specialist Division to the Building Maintenance Division in order to attract more qualified applicants for the current vacant positions, as the new title will provide a clearer understanding of the position's nature and duties; and

**WHEREAS**, the approval of the new name for the division is necessary for the efficient operation of City affairs.

## THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF FOREST PARK, GEORGIA HEREBY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1.</u> *Approval.* The Department's request to rename the City's Trade Specialist Division to the City's Building Maintenance Division as presented to the Mayor and City Council on October 7, 2024, is hereby approved.

**Section 2.** *Public Record.* This document shall be maintained as a public record by the City Clerk ("Clerk") and shall be accessible to the public during all normal business hours of the City.

<u>Section 3.</u> Authorization of Execution. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

<u>Section 4.</u> Attestation. The Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

<u>Section 5.</u> *Effective Date.* This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Forest Park as provided in the City Charter.
