APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

2. Approval of February 8, 2024, Meeting Minutes
Debra Patrick made a motion to approve the February 8, 2024, meeting minutes. Eliot Lawrence seconded the motion. 1 abstention by Yasmin Julio. Motion approved unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 3. URA History & Update
- Interim Director Dennis delivered a brief history and timeline of the transfer of land from the Army to the URA, the redevelopment of the property, and the debt service payment process.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 4. Financial Report
- Director Wiggins gave the board printed copies of their updated financials detailing current operating cash, revenues, and expenditures. The URA's current operating cash amount is about \$39,100,000. \$34 million of those funds are reserved for renovations and capital projects. The budget is currently sitting around \$5.1 million. The \$85,000 the URA approved for the Evolution event at Gillem has been transferred to the appropriate line item.
 - 5. TA Gillem Logistics 1100 Update
- Interim Director Dennis presented the board with an annual report from TA Gillem Logistics 1100 describing their job creation & fulfillment trends, current investments, and tax recovery payments.
 - Evolution Update
- The event commemorates the payment of the URA's debt to the Army. The event will be held on April 18, 2024, at the Gillem Logistics Center. \$30,000 in private funding has been secured for the event.
