A RESOLUTION BY COUNCILMEMBERS KIMBERLY JAMES, DABOUZE ANTOINE, HECTOR GUTIERREZ, LATRESA AKINS-WELLS, AND ALLAN MEARS TO ENTER INTO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH CLAYTON COUNTY FOR THE LEGACY MASQUERADE BALL

WHEREAS, the City of Forest Park (“City”) is a municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Georgia and is charged with being fiscally responsible concerning the use and expenditure of all public funds; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Recreation and Leisure Services Department and Clayton County’s Senior Services Department desire to host the first annual Legacy Masquerade Ball; and

WHEREAS, the Legacy Masquerade Ball is intended to give the seniors in the county the opportunity to come together to build interpersonal skills; and

WHEREAS, the estimated costs for the event are \$25,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) between the City and the County provides that the parties will each pay \$12,500.00 for event costs and split any and all revenue generated by the event equally.

THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FOREST PARK HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. Approval. The Memorandum of Understanding with Clayton County for the Legacy Masquerade Ball as presented to City Council on August 5, 2024 is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. Public Record. This document shall be maintained as a public record by the City Clerk and shall be accessible to the public during all normal business hours of the City of Forest Park.

SECTION 3. Authorization of Execution. The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents necessary to effectuate this Resolution.

SECTION 4. Attestation. The City Clerk is authorized to execute, attest to, and seal any documents which may be necessary to effectuate this ordinance, subject to approval as to form by the City Attorney.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Forest Park as provided in the City Charter.
