Background/History:

Seeking City Council Direction

Following the guidelines of EPA's Clean Air in Buildings Challenge, the Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Initiative sets forth to optimize indoor spaces and educate communities on the importance of better indoor air quality. The City Manager was contact by Ms. Felicia Davis, a Forest Park resident regarding the Timilon Corporation donating a number of air purifications systems to the city. The Timilon Corporation Sr. Vice President, George Negron sent to the city manager a grant award notification letter on behalf of the IAQ Initiative. This grant is to cover the full cost of installation of the EnvironKlenz Air Systems and indoor air quality monitors within the City of Forest Park Municipality Buildings and Senior Center.
