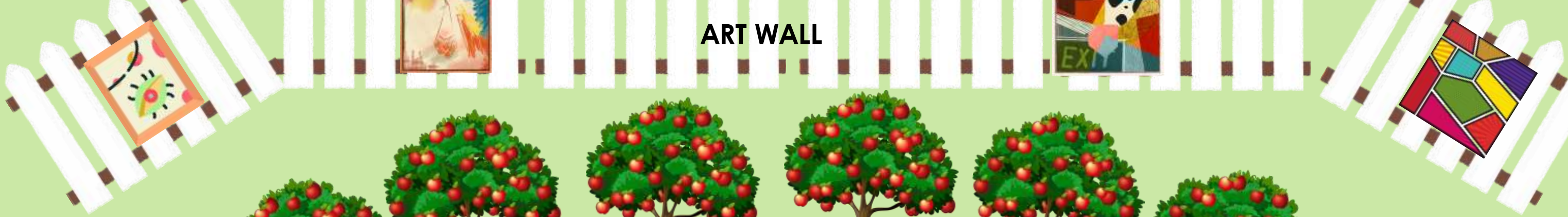

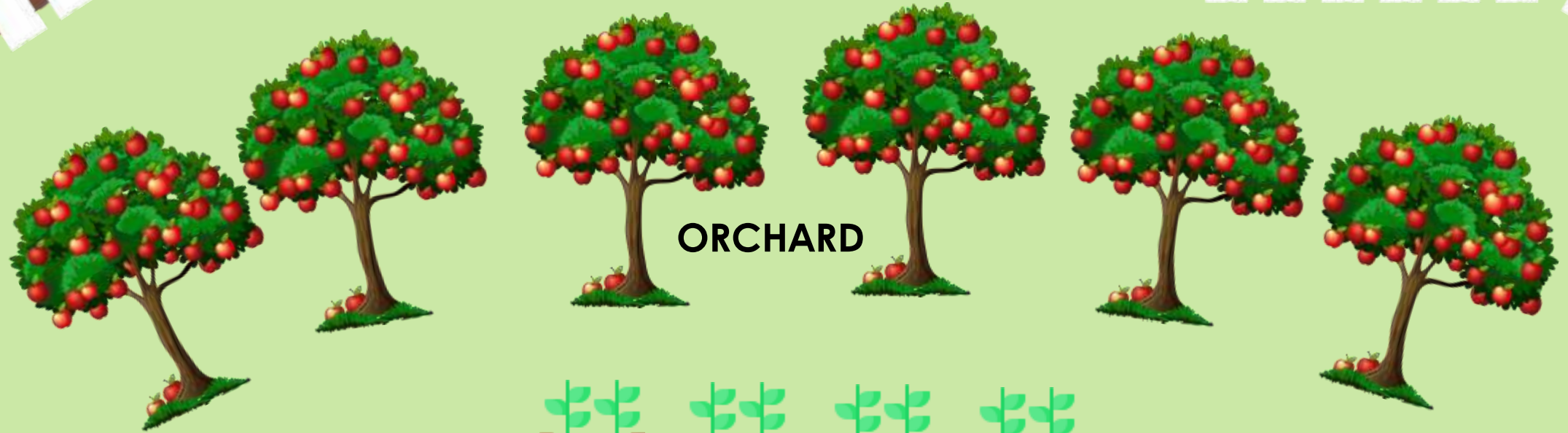

- Multi-use pavilion for events, classes, and meetings.



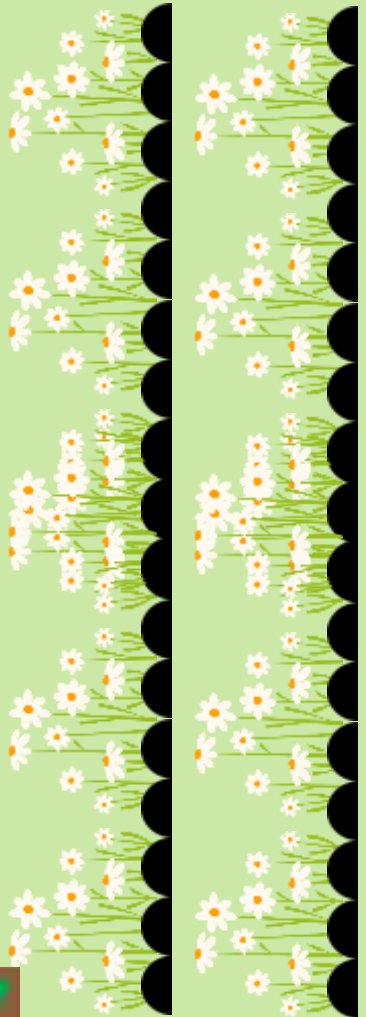
