Background/History: The City of Forest Park Police Department has completed a comprehensive audit of its evidence room. Initially, nearly 33,000 items including some dating back to 1984 were in storage. By returning items to citizens, destroying those eligible for destruction, the inventory has now been reduced to 10,500 pieces.  Currently, the police department currently holds approximately 750 firearms, which are ready for sale/auction on PropertyRoom.com. These guns, now owned by the City of Forest Park, as a result of court orders, will generate proceeds that will be deposited into either the Local Forfeiture Account or the General Fund.
