Background/History:

The fire department and EMA division applied for a grant available through the Georgia Emergency Management Agency and Homeland Security office, named the "State Homeland Security Program" or SHSP for short. The department was awarded a total of \$36,523 for two separate projects from SHSP FY2020 funding. One project, "HazMat", was awarded \$30,800 and the other project, "GSAR", was awarded \$5,723. This grant is 100% reimbursed by the State and will assist the department in obtaining a portion of the necessary and required equipment for safe operations in these areas.
