  - A. 6:00 PM – COUNCIL WORK SESSION (HOMELESSNESS: TIME, PLACE, AND MANNER):

Mayor Wenzl called the work session meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. via in-person and Zoom Webinar Video Conference.

Staff Report:

Ashley Driscoll, City Attorney, presented the Staff Report via PowerPoint, stating they would work through one topic at a time during this work session.

During the discussion, Council reached consensus to:

- Allow camping from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. when shelter is not available.
- Move forward with previously agreed upon place prohibitions (Slide 11)
- Direct Staff to identify sites that could be designated for camping within the City
- Keep previously agreed upon manner stipulations (Slides 23-25)
- Schedule another work session to discuss enforcement of the time, place, and manner ordinance
