ISSUE STATEMENT:

On April 18, 2022, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the proposed amendment to add the Forest Grove Water Master Plan to the City of Forest Grove Comprehensive Plan. After the public hearing, the Planning Commission approved a motion recommending the Forest Grove City Council adopt an ordinance amending the text of the Forest Grove Comprehensive Plan to add the Forest Grove Water System Master Plan as a technical appendix.

BACKGROUND:

The City engaged the services of Murraysmith to update the City's 2010 Water System Master Plan (WSMP). The WSMP includes information about the City's water supply, distribution system, anticipated demand, and recommended capital improvements to serve anticipated development and seismic resiliency for the next twenty years.

Prior to holding public hearings on the Comprehensive Plan amendment, a joint work session was held with the City Council and Planning Commission. The work session provided an opportunity to present the purpose of a water system master plan, what elements are included in the WSMP, and allow Commissioners and Councilors an opportunity to comment.

On April 18, 2022, the Planning Commission held a public hearing and passed a motion recommending that the Forest Grove Comprehensive Plan be amended to add the WSMP as a technical appendix.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact at this time. Any fiscal impact will be examined and determined during the rates and charges study and subsequent public process and will be part of the budget process. The rates and charges study is expected to start this next fiscal year.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the City Council have a first reading of the ordinance and public hearing on the WSMP amending the Comprehensive Plan on May 23rd. Staff further recommends to keep the public hearing open until June 13th, conduct the second reading of the WSMP amending the Comprehensive Plan, close the public hearing on June 13th, and consider adopting the ordinance.
