

## STATEMENT OF REFERENDUM PETITION SUFFICIENCY

- I, Anissa Hollingshead, City Clerk, do hereby certify that:
  - 1. On December 19, 2022, petition representatives Ross Cunniff, David Roy, and Eric Hamrick submitted a petition requesting that Council repeal Ordinance No. 114, 2022, or refer such ordinance to the registered electors of the city; and
  - 2. A referendum petition must be signed by registered electors of the city equal in number to at least ten (10) percent of the total ballots cast in the last regular city election; and
  - 3. The number of signatures of registered voters who live within the Fort Collins city limits required for said petition to be sufficient is 4,228; and
  - 4. Upon examination of the petition, I have determined that the petition contains 6,447 valid signatures, and the petition is therefore deemed sufficient to require further action by the Council; and
  - 5. This determination of sufficiency was subject to protest within ten (10) days of the filing of the petition, which deadline was 5:00 p.m. on December 29, 2022. No protest was filed by this deadline and the petition is therefore certified as sufficient.
