SUBJECT

Second Reading of Ordinance No. 087, 2026, Appropriating Unanticipated Grant Revenue from the Colorado Department of Transportation – Office of Transportation Safety and Risk Management for the Law Enforcement Assistance Fund Grant Program.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This Ordinance, unanimously adopted on First Reading on July 21, 2026, appropriates \$11,015.78 of unanticipated grant revenue from the Colorado Department of Transportation (“CDOT”) Office of Transportation Safety and Risk Management for the Law Enforcement Assistance Fund (“LEAF”) grant program. The funding will support the purchase of materials and equipment to support high visibility enforcement and impaired driving efforts.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends adoption of the Ordinance on Second Reading.

FIRST READING BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION

The LEAF grant program was created by the Colorado Legislature through statute to provide supplemental funding for local, county, and state law enforcement agencies to enforce Colorado’s impaired driving laws. Fort Collins Police Services was awarded \$11,015.78 to support the purchase of materials and equipment to support high visibility enforcement and impaired driving efforts.

CITY FINANCIAL IMPACTS

This item appropriates \$11,015.78 of unanticipated grant revenue from the CDOT Office of Transportation Safety and Risk Management. Grant funds will support the purchase of materials and equipment to support high visibility enforcement and impaired driving efforts.

The grant is reimbursement-based and does not require local match funding.
