

RESOLUTION 2026-037  
 OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS  
 MAKING APPOINTMENTS TO THE ARTS AND CULTURE  
 BOARD

A. The Arts and Culture Board has vacancies because it is a newly established board.

B. Councilmembers interviewed candidates on March 9, 2026.

C. The City Council desires to make appointments to fill these vacancies on the Arts and Culture Board.

D. In 2023, the City Council adopted a Code of Conduct and updated Boards and Commissions Policy, along with other policies and procedures that apply to service on City boards and commissions. Each board and commission appointee is required to acknowledge and accept these requirements.
