

RESOLUTION 2026-098
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
APPROVING TWO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENTS
WITH THE STATE OF COLORADO RELATING TO CONFLICT
TRANSFORMATION WORKS

A. The City's Conflict Transformation Works ("CTW") service operates restorative justice programs that promote accountability for law violations by facilitating meetings with the responsible person, the harmed person or their representative, and community members to identify the harm resulting from the offense and determine appropriate measures to repair it.

B. CTW has been partially grant-funded since 2000 and has accepted reimbursement-based grant funds on an annual basis from the Colorado Division of Criminal Justice ("CDCJ") to support City restorative justice programs. CDJC awarded the City \$35,120 for the period from July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, to fund restorative justice services. City Council appropriated these funds through Ordinance No. 064, 2026, contingent on execution of a grant agreement with CDCJ governing these funds (the "Grant Agreement"). The City has received the Grant Agreement shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

C. CTW also applied for and received a Master Agreement for Restorative Justice Services and Consulting with the Colorado Judicial Department Office of the State Court Administrator to provide restorative justice services for adults on probation in the Eighth Judicial District (the "Master Agreement"). A copy of the Master Agreement is shown on Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

D. City Charter Article II, Section 16 empowers City Council, by ordinance or resolution, to enter into contracts with governmental bodies to furnish governmental services and make charges for such services or enter into cooperative or joint activities with other governmental bodies. Section 1-22 of the City Code requires that, with some exceptions, intergovernmental agreements or cooperative activities between the City and other governmental entities be submitted to City Council for review and approval by ordinance or resolution.

In light of the foregoing recitals, which the Council hereby makes and adopts as determinations and findings, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS as follows:

Section 1. City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the Grant Agreement with the Colorado Division of Criminal Justice in substantially the form attached as Exhibit A along with such modifications as the City Manager, in consultation with the City Attorney, determines are necessary or appropriate to protect the interests of the City or effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.

Section 2. City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute the Master Agreement with the State Court Administrator's Office in substantially the form attached as Exhibit B along with such modifications as the City Manager, in consultation with the City Attorney, determines are necessary or appropriate to protect the interests of the City or effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.
