

RESOLUTION 2026-101
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
MAKING AN APPOINTMENT TO THE ENERGY BOARD

A. The Energy Board will have a vacancy due to the resignation of Aleksander Thorstensen which will be effective at the end of August.

B. Councilmembers interviewed candidates for this appointment on February 12, 2026, and identified Natalie Hanson as the alternate for appointment.

C. City Council desires to make an appointment now to fill this upcoming vacancy on the Energy Board.

D. In 2023, City Council adopted a Code of Conduct and updated the Boards and Commissions Policy, along with other policies and procedures that apply to service on City boards and commissions. Each board and commission appointee is required to acknowledge and accept these requirements.

In light of the foregoing recitals, which the Council hereby makes and adopts as determinations and findings, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS as follows:

Section 1. The following named person is hereby appointed to fill the open vacancy on the Energy Board with a term to begin and expire as noted below next to the appointee's name:
