Dear Gordon McLaughlin:

Juvenile Diversion funding is distributed to all judicial districts in Colorado via a set allocation. The allocation amount for your district is \$147,611.

Currently, the diversion funding is allocated in your district as follows:

- \$45,187 to the Office of the District Attorney
- \$66,786 to the Center for Family Outreach
- \$35,638 to City of Fort Collins
