

RESOLUTION 2026-076
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
ADOPTING AN UPDATED BUSINESS ASSISTANCE PACKAGE INCENTIVE POLICY

A. City Council has taken action to support the economic health of the City and its residents, including the adoption of policies and plans, and regularly reviews them to provide evaluation, amendment, and updates.

B. In 2013, City Council by adoption of Resolution 2013-025, approved the “Policy for Developing Primary Employer Business Assistance Packages,” (the “2013 Policy”), which was established to create a program to attract and retain primary employers as a necessary strategy for the economic health of the City.

C. City Council has regularly reviewed and updated its strategic planning for the economic health of the City, the most recent of which was to adopt Resolution 2023-111, approving the 2023 Economic Health Strategic Plan (the “2023 EHS Plan”).

D. The 2023 EHS Plan emphasized the importance making the economic health of the City resilient, sustainable, and adaptable by broadening the scope of the plan to support large and small businesses and to foster innovation.

E. In reviewing the 2013 Policy in light of the 2023 EHS Plan, as well as the current needs of the City and its residents in light of national and global economic trends, the Policy is amended to expand the business assistance tools and the types of businesses for which incentives should be considered to best support a resilient, sustainable, adaptable, and innovative economy in the City.

In light of the foregoing recitals, which the Council hereby makes and adopts as determinations and findings, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS that City Council hereby approves and adopts the Business Assistance Package Incentive Policy, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A, and repeals the 2013 Policy.
