

RESOLUTION 2026-008
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
MAKING AN APPOINTMENT TO FILL A VACANCY FOR
COUNCILMEMBER FOR DISTRICT 6 ON THE FORT COLLINS
COUNCIL

A. A vacancy for Council District 6 was created by election and swearing in of former District 6 Councilmember Emily Francis to the office of Mayor on November 4, 2025 and January 13, 2026, respectively.

B. The City Charter as updated after the November 4, 2025, election, provides that the City Council shall fill such vacancy by appointment within thirty-five business days, and that the appointed Councilmember shall serve until the end of the current four-year term of that office in January 2028.

C. The City Council has carefully considered a number of applications received from qualified District 6 residents to fill such vacancy and has interviewed such applicants.

D. The City Council desires to make an appointment to fill said vacancy on the Fort Collins City Council to serve until the District 6 voters elect a representative at the November 2027 regular municipal election, and the elected individual has taken office.

In light of the foregoing recitals, which the Council hereby makes and adopts as determinations and findings, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS that _____ is hereby appointed to fill the vacancy created by the swearing in of Emily Francis as Mayor, to serve as District 6 Councilmember on the Fort Collins City Council until an elected representative for District 6 has taken office following the November 2027 regular municipal election.
