RIVER STREET RESURFACING PROJECT

Scope/Description: This Resolution is the final legislation required by ODOT for the

resurfacing of River Street from W Second Street to Van Horne Avenue (ODOT PID No. 119971). The project consists of pavement planning, pavement repair, resurfacing, and pavement marking, along with repair of curb and gutter, storm sewer, curb ramp installation and

sidewalk.

Budget Impact:

The City share of the project will come from the ODOT Program

Fund. The final estimate for the project is \$1,220,400.00. The City's

share of the project is \$281,610.00.

ENACTING THE FINAL LEGISLATION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) TO COMPLETE RIVER STREET RESURFACING PROJECT

The following Final Resolution enacted by the City of Franklin, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Legislative Authority/Local Public Agency or "LPA", in the matter of the stated described project.

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of July 2025, the LPA, by Resolution 2025-45, enacted legislation proposing cooperation with the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") Director of Transportation for the described project ("Project"):

The project consists of resurfacing River Street (S.R. 123), North of W. Second Street to Van Horne Avenue, including curb, curb ramps, curb and gutter, sidewalk, drainage upgrades, pavement repair, pavement planning, and pavement markings, lying within the City of Franklin; and

WHEREAS, the LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described Project as follows:

The City agrees to assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of the improvement within the city limits, less the amount of Federal-Aid funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U. S. Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, The share of the cost of the LPA is now estimated in the amount of Two Hundred Eighty-One Thousand Six Hundred Ten and - - - - 00/100 Dollars, (\$281,610.00), but said estimated amount is to be adjusted in order that the LPA's ultimate share of said improvement shall correspond with said percentages of actual costs when said actual costs are determined; and

WHEREAS, The Director of Transportation has approved said legislation proposing cooperation and has caused to be made plans and specifications and an estimate of cost and expense for improving the above described project and has transmitted copies of the same to this legislative authority; and

WHEREAS, The LPA desires the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of Council members present concurring, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the estimated sum, of Two Hundred Eighty-One Thousand Six Hundred Ten and - - - 00/100 Dollars, (\$281,610.00) is hereby appropriated for the improvement described above and the fiscal officer is hereby authorized and directed to issue an order on the treasurer for said sum upon the requisition of the Director of Transportation to pay the cost and expense of said improvement. We hereby agree to assume in the first instance, the share of the cost and expense over and above the amount to be paid from Federal funds.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the LPA hereby requests the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

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<u>Section 3.</u> That the LPA enter into a contract with the State, and that the City Manager be, and is hereby authorized to execute said contract, providing for the payment of the LPA the sum of money set forth herein above for improving the described project.

<u>Section 4.</u> That the LPA transmit to the Director of Transportation a fully executed copy of this Resolution.

<u>Section 5.</u> It is hereby found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.
