Committee was appointed in 2021). The purpose of the Committee is

to recommend to Council any changes to the Charter it deems advisable. The Committee will have until November 30, 2025 to submit any such proposed changes to Council for the May 2026 election. This deadline will give Council the necessary time to review the proposed amendments, if any, before deciding whether to place them on the May 2026 ballot. Their work may continue in 2026 for the

November 2026 or May 2027 election.
