Scope/Description: Resurfacing of the eastbound travel lanes along 1.03 miles of S.R. 73

> from the city limits at the Butler/Warren County line to the S. Main Street/Dixie Highway intersection. The westbound lanes will be

completed separately as part of Phase II of the project.

This Resolution is the first step in the application for funding process, with funds to be distributed in 2031. If funding is received, the City's local share would be approximately 25% of the overall project cost for

the State Route 73 Improvement Project.

The Engineer's estimated cost for this Project is \$1,200,960

(estimated Local Share \$340,740).

This Project is scheduled for the first quarter of the State's 2031 fiscal

year.

Budget Impact: The total cost for this Project will be budgeted in the ODOT Program

Fund.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL ILIA FUNDS THROUGH THE MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION FOR STP FUNDING FY31

WHEREAS, the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (MVRPC) has solicited local government entities to submit new transportation projects for funding consideration in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Ohio has committed to a timely project development schedule; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Ohio will commit the necessary resources to support the estimated local cost portion of the project; and

WHEREAS, the authorized project will be submitted to MVRPC and shall include an estimate of the City's matching fund amount;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of the members present concurring, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Manager is hereby authorized to submit an application for the following transportation project to MVRPC for funding consideration under the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP):

1. State Route 73 Resurfacing Project – Phase I (Eastbound), from the city limits at the Butler/Warren County line to the S. Main Street/Dixie Highway intersection. (Estimated Local Share \$340,740.00, funding year 2031); and

<u>Section 2.</u> The Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, hereby requests the following exemption from MVRPC's Complete Streets Policy for the proposed project funding application:

1. Resurfacing (Exemption 4) - The project consists of maintenance, repair and resurfacing of an existing cross section only (Cyclist and pedestrian exemption).

<u>Section 3.</u> The City Manager is hereby authorized to sign on behalf of the City, the application for funds for the above-listed eligible project activities, and to execute all necessary documents related to said application and program activities.

<u>Section 4.</u> The City Manager is hereby directed and authorized to take, or cause to be taken, all other action necessary and proper to secure the funding sought by the application referred to herein, and provide any additional information sought by reviewing agencies during the time the Application is under review. The City Manager is further directed and authorized to cause compliance will all reporting requirements required by MVRPC as part of the funding process.

<u>Section 5.</u> Upon approval of the application, the City hereby states its commitment to the local contribution for the project as identified in this application, including local contribution of costs exceeding the current estimates or subsequent revised estimates as accepted by MVRPC.

<u>Section 6.</u> It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements,
