Scope/Description: This Resolution authorizes the City Manager to apply for a

NatureWorks Grant to install new equipment at Community Park for safety and security. This work would include installing lightning protection, three security cameras and two automatic vehicle gates

that will be installed for security.

Budget Impact: The cost of this project is currently estimated at \$66,000, and the

City's share would be \$16,500. If our application for the grant is approved, the NatureWorks Grant Program is a reimbursement-type program, so the City would have to pay the entire project cost upfront, and we would then be reimbursed \$49,500 under the Grant Program. The costs for this Project would be paid out of the Recreation Fund.

CITY OF FRANKLIN, OHIO RESOLUTION 2022-54

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A NATUREWORKS GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes through the State of Ohio NatureWorks Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin desires financial assistance under the NatureWorks Grant Program to install a improvements at the City of Franklin Community Park;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Franklin, Ohio, a majority of members present concurring, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is hereby authorized to submit, on behalf of the City of Franklin, a NatureWorks Grant application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for financial assistance to install new equipment at the City of Franklin Community Park for safety and security. This work would include installing lightning protection, three security cameras and two automatic vehicle gates that will be installed for security measures, and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible financial assistance.

<u>Section 2</u>. This Council does hereby agree to obligate any funds necessary to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the NatureWorks Grant Program, if the City's application for financial assistance is approved.

<u>Section 3</u>. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
