

RESOLUTION 2026-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FROSTBURG, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, APPROVING THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE DUTIES OF DAM KEEPER INTO THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS.

WHEREAS, the City of Frostburg owns and operates a municipal dam and associated facilities that require routine monitoring, oversight, and compliance with applicable operational and regulatory requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that the duties and responsibilities of the Dam Keeper are closely aligned with the existing responsibilities of the Director of Public Works, who is responsible for the management, operation, maintenance, and oversight of the City's infrastructure and water systems; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works will reside in the City-owned residence located at the dam property, thereby providing enhanced proximity to the facility and improving the City's ability to monitor and respond to issues affecting the dam and related infrastructure; and,

WHEREAS, the consolidation of these responsibilities will not materially increase the workload of the Director of Public Works, will reduce expenditures, and will promote operational efficiency through increased oversight; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find that consolidating the duties of the Dam Keeper into the position of Director of Public Works is in the best interests of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Mayor and City Council of Frostburg, Maryland do hereby incorporate and assign the duties previously assigned to the position of Dam Keeper into the position of Director of Public Works for a one-year trial period effective July 1, 2026.
