AGENDA TEXT: ORDINANCE 2022-28 – First Reading – An introduction of an Ordinance repealing and replacing Chapter 2.70 of the Fruita Municipal Code concerning a Code of Ethics for City Officials for public hearing on December 6, 2022

BACKGROUND

During the 2022 City Council Orientation & Training workshop, City Council discussed the dated language of the Code of Ethics found in Chapter 2.70 of the Municipal Code. The Council directed staff to draft an Ordinance to align the City's Code of Ethics with the State of Colorado's and to simplify the language in the Code.

At the September 27, 2022 Council workshop meeting, a draft Code of Ethics and draft Ordinance to repeal and replace the current Chapter 2.70 of the Municipal Code was discussed. The City Council gave staff direction to move forward with the proposed changes to the Municipal Code.
