Ute Water

- Fees for the proposed 39 units will be calculated at \$166,600.00 for a single master meter to serve all units billed to an HOA or management co.
- Show offsite 10-inch water main extension to the western edge of the subject property. Water main ex shall commence just west of Commerce Ct and replace all of the ex 6-inch WM.
- Existing WM shall be salvaged with the line extension and returned to the District in good condition, this service shall be replaced by the proposed new tap and meter.
- A BFPD should be called out for the domestic service, placement should be just downstream of the proposed water meter.
- Show a BFPD in a heated utility cabinet on the fire lateral just behind the sidewalk.
- Both fire lateral device and domestic device can be placed in the same cabinet.
- Domestic water shall not be used for irrigation. Developer must secure irrigation rights/water for irrigation purposes, water taps/meters will not be sold for irrigation of landscaping.
- Water is tied to the parcel it is intended to serve it shall not be conveyed from one parcel to another.
- A cross connection survey must be submitted and reviewed prior to acceptance, survey may be found at the following link (http://www.utewater.org/backflow) once completed submit it and mechanical drawings (plumbing both domestic and fire suppression only) to the District (Joseph Lambert) for further review and approvals.
- Installation of all backflow equipment shall be per Ute Water approval. Developer will be required to engineer, purchase, install and maintain all necessary equipment.
- An initial test on only the domestic BFPD will be made by the District at no cost for the developer; arrangements for this first test should be made with District personnel for final approval.
- Submit mechanical drawing and a completed survey to: Joseph Lambert
