BACKGROUND

Pursuant to Article 5 of the Fruita City Charter, the City Council may appoint additional Associate Municipal Judges as may be necessary to act in case of temporary absence of the Presiding Municipal Judge. The contract with Greg Mueller will expire on January 31, 2022. Associate Judge Mueller is interested in continuing his service with the City. Attached is a copy of the Personal Service Agreement for Associate Municipal Judge Mueller.

FISCAL IMPACT

Compensation will remain at \$535 per session The contract does not have any additional impact on the 2022 Budget. The 2022 Budget includes additional funds sufficient for payment of the Associate Municipal Judge in the absence of the Presiding Municipal Judge.
