AGENDA TEXT: PROCLAMATION POLICY DISCUSSION

BACKGROUND

The Fruita City Council adopted Resolution 2020-44 establishing a policy on the issuance of Proclamations on November 17, 2020. A copy of the policy is attached. The policy states that proclamations that have historically been issued on an annual basis will NOT be automatically renewed and that requests must be made on an annual basis. The purpose of this discussion is to decide whether or not to amend this policy to provide for automatic renewal of certain proclamations.

The following is a list of historical proclamations that have been issued in multiple years:
